

SUPERCALC™

SUPERCALC is designed to act as a simple means of tapping the power of the computer to make it do the time-consuming things you used to do with paper, pencils and a calculator. Words and numbers are displayed in a worksheet format. Status information and prompt messages on the screen assist you in setting up your worksheet. The screen acts as a window representing a part of the worksheet. You can manipulate the content of the entire worksheet by pressing a few characters on the keyboard. SUPERCALC lets you specify which data will be displayed, where, and in what format (e.g., integers, dollars and cents, scientific notations, etc.). To guide you, various "help" messages are available at all times while you are working on the program.

SUPERCALC is an indispensable tool for exploring possibilities and comparing alternatives in everyday decision-making processes. Data can be changed easily and numbers recalculated quickly. The program efficiently and accurately displays information, thus aiding you in developing complete and consistent reports. Once worksheets are generated they can be stored on disks to access, edit, and print later.

SUPERCALC features include:

- View The Status of The Active Cell on The Screen:
 - current direction of the cursor
 - active cell location
 - active cell format
 - data protection
 - contents of the active cell
- View The Status of The Entire Worksheet on The Screen:
 - column width
 - available memory
 - last cell of the worksheet
- Press "?" and SUPERCALC will display help screens to guide you with your work.

- Split the display window into either two separate vertical or horizontal windows to view two different sections of the worksheet simultaneously.
- Display information graphically in the form of horizontal bar graph.
- Insert or delete a column or row.
- Specify the format for a cell or group of cells, a column, row, or the entire worksheet. Specify:
 - numeric types
 - dollar amounts
 - right or left justification
 - column width
- Clear the contents and cell format of a cell, partial column, partial row, or block. Clear the contents of the entire worksheet.
- Edit the contents of any cell not defined as protected.
- Enter information only once, then copy a cell, partial column, partial row, or block into other areas of the worksheet.
- Save the worksheet on a disk so that you can call it in at a later time — or have it printed at your convenience.

Arithmetic operations include addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, and exponential numbers (powers).

Logical operations are, AND, OR, NOT, & IF . . . THEN . . . ELSE.

Relationships are equal to, not equal to, less than, less than or equal to, greater than, and greater than or equal to.

Functions available to SUPERCALC users are max, min, count, sum, average, square root, common and natural logs, absolute value, exponential value, integer portion of value, search for last value less than or equal to X, net present value at given rate of discount, Pi, Sin and ASin, Cos and ACos, and Tan and ATan.
